# **Charity Teddies**

You will need: double knitting yarn

- Main colour for head and paws
- Trouser colour
- Jumper colour
- Scarf colour Size 9 (3.75cm) needles.
- Acrylic toy stuffing. Do not use foam as this can be dangerous to children.

### Main part

Paw colour - cast on 10 sts. Knit 10 rows.

Change to Trouser colour – Knit 30 rows. Leave on a spare needle and make another leg to match.

Knit across the 2 legs (20 sts). Knit 16 rows in trouser colour.

Change to jumper colour and knit 24 rows.

Change to Paw colour and work 38 rows in stocking stitch.

Change to Jumper colour and knit 24 rows.

Change to trouser colour and knit 16 rows.

Knit 10 sts and turn. Knit 30 rows.

Change to Paw colour and knit 10 rows. Cast off.

Join trouser colour and complete other leg to match.

#### Arms. - make 2.

Paw colour. Cast on 12 sts. Knit 10 rows.

Change to Jumper colour. Knit 20 rows. Cast off.

### Scarf.

Cast on 75 sts. Knit 5 rows. Cast off.

## To make up.

Sew up side seams and inner legs leaving an opening for stuffing Sew up and stuff arms and sew onto body.

To shape head.

Sew running sts around the base of the head and draw up to make the neck.

Sew running sts across the corners of the head.

Sew eyes, nose and mouth on to face.

Ensure that all ends are firmly finished.
