

I - cord snake pattern. Knit.

Small amounts of yarn, double knitting or 4 ply.

Double pointed needles in appropriate size for selected yarn.

This pattern is based on an icord. There are lots of tutorials on youtube if you have never made an icord before.

Abbreviations.

KFB – Knit into front and back of the stitch.

Snake Pattern. 2 sizes.

Start by making an icord with 3 (or 6) stitches.

Make the icord the length you want your snake's body to be E.g. 13cm for small/ 19cm for large.

Next row – begin knitting by rows.

KFB into each stitch across the row. Turn 6 (12) sts.

KFB, Knit 4 (10)sts, KFB. Turn. 8 (14)sts.

Knit across. Turn.

Purl across. Turn.

Knit across. Turn.

Purl across. Turn.

Knit across. Turn.

Purl across. Turn.

K2tog, Knit 4(10)sts,K2tog. Turn. 6(12) sts.

P2tog,Purl 2(8)sts. P2tog. Turn 4(10) sts.

Cast off in knit.

Embroider eyes with black thread and tie on and knot a piece of red yarn for the tongue.

Weave in all the ends.
